





Digital Piano Care Guide

Choose the Location Carefully

Avoid placing the piano near windows or doors as rain may strike it through the window or the instrument could be knocked by a door opening.

Also inappropriate are openings that expose the piano to sunlight, dust or extreme temperatures. Moisture, humidity and drastic temperatures can damage the exterior surface as well as electrical components.

Ensure keyboard is used with a suitable, sturdy, reliable keyboard stand at home.

Avoid Food and Drinks

Don't place food or beverages on top of the piano surface.

Use a Piano Cover

A digital piano should be dusted with a clean, dry cloth on a regular basis. A piano cover should be used whenever the user is not playing it. DO NOT USE wet cloth or household cleaners on the piano!

Keep Hands Clean

Before using the piano the player should make sure his or her hands are free from dirt, grease or grime.

Power Off

When your machine is not being used make sure to turn it off. Leaving the electronic device on when not in use prevents unnecessary wear on the piano's components.
