Care of Electronic Drum Sets

- Clean the module with a soft and dry cloth only. Do not let moisture build up on the module.
- If you have grime or stains on your module, use a slightly damp cloth. Do not use industrial cleaners, OTC cleaners or soapy cloth.
Avoid using alcohol and thinners on your module.
- Never place vinyl objects on top of the module. This can permanently discolour the module.

The electronic drum set contains a lot of electrical wiring and connections. If you think there is something wrong with the wiring, take it back to the Library. Do not attempt to fix it yourself by opening the module.

How to carefully transport and move the electronic module without incurring damage?

Just like any other instrument, you need to be extremely careful.

- Do not pull on the cable while unplugging the module. Grip the plug firmly and tug.
- Do not drop, knock or bump your module. Do not place heavy things on the module. This can cause serious damage, and the module can acquire scratches.
- The only cables that should be removed are the two that go into the cymbal pads as the pads have to be removed and stored in the case for transport, and the cable in the hi hat pedal, as it too, needs to be put in its own case and stored in the travelling case. All the other cabled should not be removed.
Do not apply excessive stress to the connectors and controls. Always handle the
- modules gently.
